During the second week of February, my family and I took a 6-day, 5-night trip to Fort Lauderdale. For the first three days of our trip, we spent time together enjoying the warm and breezy February weather in Florida. Since Jae had a conference to attend, I took care of our 15-month old baby, Gabie, for the rest of the trip. On Jae's first day of the conference, she suggested that it would be convenient for me to handle Gabie if I were to utilize a food delivery service, like Uber Eats, and dine in the hotel room instead of going out for lunch. Although I knew Jae was right, I decided to take a chance and do something I had never done—go out for lunch with my daughter. I secured Gabie in her stroller and ensured that I had all the necessary items with me.

Upon leaving the hotel, I realized that I had forgotten my phone in our hotel room. After a moment of hesitation, I decided against returning to the room for my phone because I didn't need it since Jae was in the middle of a conference and I wasn't expecting any important phone calls. Also, I didn't want to waste my time going back to the room and Gabie might become fussy or irritable if we were out for too long. Above all, I wanted to cherish the moment with my daughter and didn't want my phone to interrupt our special time together. After spending uninterrupted quality time with Gabie, I felt deeply content with my decision.

As I reflected on this experience, it dawned on me that this is also what we can do during the Lenten season: immerse ourselves in the presence of God.

Perhaps the key to a fruitful Lenten season lies in abstaining from digital distractions such as email, online shopping, streaming video, social media, or abstaining form your favorite treat, such as desserts, coffee, or meat. By abstaining form digital distractions and favorite treats, we may find ourselves better able to focus on our spiritual goals and create a more profound experience during our journey to the Cross with Christ.

With one month left, until Easter, how do you intend to enhance your spiritual connection with God during Lent?
